- Presentations should be 'state of the science', i.e. the latest data/findings in the SCC project
- Presentations should **not** be a repeat of the grant proposal
- The PI or one of the Co-PIs should speak; no duets
- Speakers need to keep their introductions short and keep to time

An abstract of the presentation will be included in the retreat abstract book.

Abstract Instructions:

Abstracts must be sent as electronic files (MSWord) to: SCC@mskcc.org by March 31, 2017.

- 1. SCC-funded project title should appear in all capital letters.
- 2. List the PI, Co-PIs and team members and their affiliations; list other authors as necessary.
- 3. Underline the name of the presenter
- 4. Format as a **single** page with:
 - a. 1.5 inch margins
 - b. Times New Roman, 12 pt font
 - c. Single space
