Poster Presentation Instructions

Posters will be viewable on CSHL's virtual poster platform, which will go live at 9am on Monday May 3 and remain available through end of day Tuesday May 4. Posters in PDF format **MUST** be uploaded to the CSHL website <https://meetings.cshl.edu/upload/> by end of day **Monday April 26**. Late submission may lead to delayed availability of the poster in the virtual hall. Posters are not downloadable or printable.

SCC projects from the 13th and 14th grant competitions are required to present a poster.

The poster should state the original goals of the project, the proposed contributions of each laboratory, and summarize what has been achieved.

Design your poster according to the layout on the following page.

Technical requirements for the posters:

1. File size: ≤6 MB
2. Resolution: 72 dpi
3. Orientation: Either landscape or portrait is acceptable
4. Dimensions: Any, EXCEPT excessive length / width
5. File Name: PDF files should be named with the format: SCC_21_lastname (e.g. "SCC_21_smith")
6. Submit: Upload PDF file to <https://meetings.cshl.edu/upload/> by April 26
